Mayor Lawrence stated that there are two Vacancies open in the Housing Authority. One is due to the death of Vonce Farrow. Mayor Lawrence recommended Stephanie Pitts to fill the unexpired term of Mr. Farrow with the term ending September 18, 2024. The next appointment recommendation is Mary Cantrell who is currently serving on the board and would like to be reappointed. Mayor Lawrence stated that he would like to consider a different way of selection boards to insure that people who want to serve to know what positions are available. Mayor Lawrence called on Mayor Pro Tem for his input. Councilmember Raffield stated that the idea behind our boards and commissions within the city is to serve our community for the greater good and benefit of everyone inside of it. As an organization, we are always looking for better ways to increase public engagement and education on how we operate and how we can continue to operate in a more effective manner. Councilmember Raffield suggested that Council look to City Manager and administration to prepare a procedure for selecting and appointing open positions on boards. Councilmember Raffield stated that moving forward if there is a vacancy the elected body needs to be notified as well as the public to ensure that anyone interested in serving will have the opportunity. Ms. Jammes stated that staff is up to the task and has already discussed ideas on how to set up the process. Staff will start this process after the first of the year. Councilmember Looney asked Attorney Mr. Syfan if the change would require a change to the City Charter. Mr. Syfan stated that the charter would not need to be changed and he would check the language in the Charter to see if requires an ordinance or resolution. Councilmember Proctor stated that some of the appointments are constitutional and governed by state law.
